Celebrating its twelfth season, the Halcyon Music Festival brings together two dozen stellar classical musicians and outstanding young virtuosi to perform six concerts each June. Over the years, HMF has attracted thousands of attendees from the greater Seacoast and beyond, including the Boston metropolitan area. All concerts take place at St. John's Episcopal Church in Portsmouth, New Hampshire.

Expanding the Reach of Classical Music

Halcyon Music Festival strives to make chamber music accessible to all, including those who might not otherwise experience it in concert halls. To encourage attendance by a broad and diverse audience, the festival asks for a suggested donation of \$45, rather than charging a standard ticket fee.

The festival aims to create a community that will inspire great musicians to collaborate at the highest professional level. Living, rehearsing, and performing together over the span of two weeks generates an energy that is palpable to audiences and elevates the music to a new level.

As violist Tatjana Chamis observes, "Halcyon captures the true essence of a chamber music festival. Halcyon artists—who are passionate about creating music and sharing a culture of art that uplifts audiences and inspires higher levels of creativity—come from the best orchestras, chamber groups, and schools to create, in just two weeks, musical magic."

World-Class Musicians

Founder and Artistic Director **Heng-Jin Park** established the Halcyon Music Festival in 2013. An accomplished and widely respected classical pianist, Heng-Jin has performed extensively throughout the United States and abroad, both as a soloist and part of the critically-acclaimed Boston Trio. She formerly served as Artistic Director of the Killington Music Festival, and currently holds faculty positions at Harvard University, MIT, and New England Conservatory Preparatory School.



Each year, Heng-Jin combines her virtuosity, extensive network of world-class musicians, and vast knowledge of chamber music to create a one-of-a-kind experience for performers and audience members alike.
